



The classic tribute to hope from the Holocaust

HOPE

“Hope ends in fruition”, and sometimes fruition is not possible

Hope alone does not fuel man in extreme circumstance

However, hope can help us envision an ideal future





FAITH

Allegiance to duty or a person;

Belief and trust in and loyalty to God; and

Something that is believed especially with strong conviction.

FIRST VATICAN COUNCIL

“Faith is a supernatural virtue by which we, with the inspiration and assistance of God's grace, believe those things to be true which He has revealed... although the assent of faith is in no sense blind, yet no one can assent to the Gospel teaching in the way necessary for salvation without the illumination of the Holy Spirit.”
